Game System

Singles

preliminary round in groups of as many as 4 players as possible, who are represented in the system of each
Play against anyone. First to second place players advance to the main round, the others in the consolation round. Main round and consolation round in the single KO-System.

Doubles

Preliminary round in groups of 4 pairings, each against each other.
play; First and second-placed teams advance to the main round, which others in the consolation round, main round and consolation round in the single knockout system.

Waiting list for interested parties:

In order to ensure a high quality of the tournament and a personal atmosphere, the capacities in the hall are limited. We therefore run the event as an invitation tournament, but keep it "open" for all interested parties through a transparent succession procedure:

Registration for invited guests:

Invited participants please confirm their place by 25.05.2026 by paying the entry fee. Unconfirmed contingents will be released immediately to the people on the waiting list after this deadline.

Draw

The preliminary round is set according to QTTR value. The seeding list for the main round and consolation round results from the preliminary round results. The draws take place before the start of the competition in the hall.

Prices

Medals for the first three places of the main rounds.

Chief Referee

Will be announced at the start of the tournament.

Referee

It is required that the participants also act as referees. It can be expected that participants are also able to lead a table tennis game.

All participants therefore commit themselves by registering to officiate matches of others as referees on request. Failure to comply with a corresponding request by the tournament management can lead to exclusion from the tournament.

Arbitration

Three people will be named at the start of the tournament.

Rules of the Game

The tournament is played according to the international table tennis rules. The following modifications apply:

PPP Juist Open 2026

Serve: The umpire can determine the requirements for a correct serve if he is convinced that compliance is prevented by a physical disability or lack of table tennis experience.

In addition, if the server does not gain a direct advantage from the faulty serve, the umpire should relax the requirements, even if the serve is wrong.

Rally: A player may cross the table with his club hand or free hand to restore his balance after a blow and when the table does not move. The player must not use the table as an additional support to gain an advantage before touching the ball.

Breaks and interruptions

The referee may grant a stoppage of play of as short a duration as possible, but not more than ten minutes, if a player is temporarily disabled due to an accident or medication. If a player wishes an interruption of longer than 10 minutes, this can only be approved by the chief referee, once per player and tournament day. This grants a longer break of a maximum of another 10 minutes.

Catering

During the tournament, catering will be provided by the Jugendbildungsstätte Theodor Wuppermann e.V. after prior registration. Lunch is provided in the form of a packed lunch. Catering on your own is possible.

Is guaranteed during the tournament.

Accommodation

Sufficient rooms have been reserved at the Theodor Wuppermann e.V. youth education centre. If you do not want to organize accommodation in the village of Juist yourself.

Remarks

The event is subject to the proviso that it may be cancelled due to official instructions must be restricted or cancelled. The participants bear this risk yourself!
